To view your official sample ballot, use the polling place and sample ballot look-up tool at sfelections.org/toolkit.

How to Change My Party

To change your registration for this election, you must complete and submit a voter registration card by May 21:

- Download a registration card at the California Secretary of State's website, sos.ca.gov
- Request a registration card from the Department of Elections at (415) 554-4375; or
- Fill out a registration card in person at the Department of Election in City Hall, Room 48.

No Party Preference

Card 1

You have three options for this card:

1. American Independent Party candidates for President, plus state and local ballot measures;
OR
2. Democratic Party candidates for President, plus state and local ballot measures;
OR
3. No presidential primary; just state and local ballot measures

To request a party ballot for Card 1:

- If you vote at a polling place: request that ballot from a pollworker on Election Day
- If you vote by mail: return the Department's request form (sent in March and April, and included in the vote-by-mail packet).
